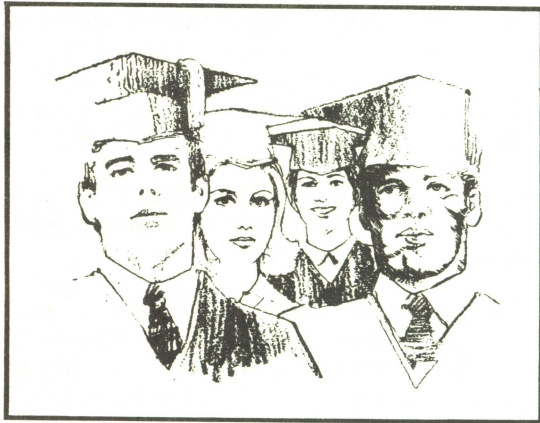

ACADEMIC COSTUME

The caps, gowns, and hoods worn at college and university functions date back to the Middle Ages. Monks and students wore them to keep warm in the damp and drafty halls of learning. Gradually, styles were adopted which were characteristic of the individual college and of the academic degree held by the wearer.

Students receiving an Associate degree wear a black gown similar to the bachelor's costume. The gown has a semi-stiff yoke, long pleated front, and intricate shirring across the shoulder and back.

The gown for the Bachelor's degree is black as are all gowns, signifying advanced degrees. The bachelor's gown is usually worn closed and is primarily distinguished by its long, pointed sleeves.

The holder of the Master's degree wears a gown with oblong sleeves, open at the wrist. The sleeve base is square cut with an arc in front.

The gown for the Doctor's degree carries broad velvet panels down the front and three velvet bars on the full, round, open sleeves. This velvet trimming may be either black or the color distinctive of the degree.

The square "mortar board" cap is traditional for all degrees. This cap may be of serge, broadcloth, or, for the Doctor's costume only, velvet. The tassel of the Doctor's cap may be of gold bullion.

The hood gives color and meaning to the academic costume. The color lining the hood indicates where the degree was earned. The color trimming the hood indicates the discipline of the wearer's degree. The trimming colors indicate the following:
