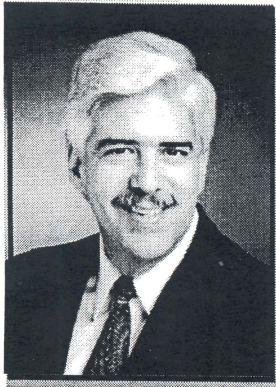


MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

THE COLLEGE MACE



The mace was an effective weapon in battle during the Middle Ages. As newer and more powerful military arms were developed, it was transformed into a symbol of authority.

The earliest ceremonial maces were carried by bodyguards of 12th century English and French kings. By the end of the 16th century, they were used widely by officials of English cities and towns. Today, the ceremonial mace is found in the British Houses of Parliament and is carried in front of ecclesiastical processions and commencement ceremonies.

The Lake-Sumter Community College Mace was carried for the first time on May 14, 1993. The mace used today was designed and constructed by Wilson Sheppard of Sorrento and incorporates the Lake-Sumter Community College Seal.

THE PRESIDENTIAL MEDALLION



The Presidential Medallion is a symbol of academic leadership. It is worn by the College President at formal and ceremonial occasions. The Gold Medallion marks the President as a distinguished scholar, administrator and the highest officer of the College, who strives to uphold the tenets established by the founders of the institution.

The Medallion is embossed with the College Seal and is a visible reminder to each College community member to think and to strive to reach individual goals.

The President has been entrusted to maintain and develop an atmosphere where these creeds can be realized. The Presidential position represented by the Medallion epitomizes the foundations and aspirations of the College which the President has pledged to uphold.

As the only College official who can formally award a degree, the President recognizes each graduate individually for meeting the standards of excellence set by the College and for reaching the point from which new ventures begin.

LEADERSHIP CORDS

Each year, Lake-Sumter Community College recognizes students who have demonstrated leadership in campus groups and organizations. Graduating students involved in Student Activities receive green leadership cords to be worn with their gowns at Commencement.

ACADEMIC REGALIA

The caps, gowns, and hoods worn at college and university functions date back to the Middle Ages. Monks and students wore them to keep warm in the damp and drafty halls of learning. Gradually, styles were adopted which were characteristic of the individual college and of the academic degree held by the wearer.

Students receiving an Associate degree wear a black gown with a semi-stiff yoke, long pleated front, and intricate shirring across the shoulder and back.

The gown for the Bachelor's degree is also black, as are all gowns signifying advanced degrees. The Bachelor's gown is usually worn closed and is distinguished by its long, pointed sleeves.

The holder of the Master's degree wears a gown with oblong sleeves, open at the wrist. The sleeve base is square cut with an arc in front.

Students receiving their Doctor's degrees wear gowns with broad velvet panels down the front and three velvet bars on the full, round, open sleeves. This velvet trimming may be either black or the color distinctive of the degree.

The square "mortar board" cap, traditional for all degrees, may be of serge or broadcloth. For the Doctor's degree only, it may be of velvet and the tassel may be of gold bullion.

The hood gives color and meaning to the academic costume. The color lining of the hood indicates where the degree was earned, while the color trimming indicates the discipline of the degree. Disciplines are represented by the following colors:

COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER

RAYMOND GILLEY



Since April 2001, Mr. Raymond Gilley has been President and Chief Executive Officer of the Metro Orlando Economic Development Commission, a regional marketing organization serving Lake, Orange, Osceola and Seminole counties, as well as the City of Orlando.

Prior to leading the operations of this organization with a budget of \$5.7 million and a staff of 38, Mr. Gilley spent 15 years with Progress Energy Corporation, the state's second largest electric utility company. There, he had oversight of community affairs, issues management, strategic marketing, planning, customer service, economic development and business expansion. His previous five years in research and national business development roles with the Florida Department of

Commerce were an excellent training ground for all his future endeavors. He is a 1980 graduate of Florida State University, with a degree in marketing.

In 1999, Governor Jeb Bush appointed Mr. Gilley to serve on the Lake-Sumter Community College District Board of Trustees, where he remains an active member. Mr. Gilley also served, by Governor appointment, as chair of the Board of Workforce Florida, Inc., from 2002 to 2005. In that capacity, he directed and monitored the administration of the state's workforce policy, programs and services. In this role, Gilley succeeded Florida's current Lt. Governor Toni Jennings.

Other current governor/legislative appointments and recent leadership roles include: Trustee of Orlando Regional Healthcare System, Foundation Board of the University of Central Florida, Board of Directors of Enterprise Florida, Board of Directors of Junior Achievement, Oversight Commission for the Orange County Jail, Workforce Central Florida, Lake County Industrial Development Authority, and Trustee of WMFE public television station.

Over the years, Mr. Gilley has served on two local and regional bank boards and a credit union, and is a past volunteer president of several local chambers of commerce and chairman of several community-based non-profit organizations.

Mr. Gilley is an active resident of Lake County, where he was named Citizen of the Year in 2002. He and his wife Gina are the proud parents of a 21 year old son, Adam, and two daughters, Aneesa, age 17 and Ameena, age 13.

LAKE - SUMTER COMMUNITY COLLEGE

LSCC was authorized by the 1961 Florida Legislature as the result of efforts of citizens in Lake and Sumter counties. Dr. Paul P. Williams was appointed in 1962 as the College's first president.

The College began operating as part of the state community college system on January 2, 1962. Classes began September 5, 1962, with 137 day students and 225 evening students. Tuition was \$8 per semester hour.

After outgrowing temporary facilities in Leesburg, ground breaking for LSCC's permanent campus took place on May 18, 1964, with Governor Farris Bryant, Dr. James Wattenbarger, and local officials in attendance. The first College Commencement was held on June 5, 1964, in the Leesburg High School Auditorium with 39 graduates receiving recognition from Doyle Conner, Commissioner of Agriculture.

In 1965, Johnson Junior College merged with Lake-Sumter Junior College and operated as the Johnson Center of Lake-Sumter Junior College. Johnson Junior College was authorized in 1961 to serve the black citizens of Lake and Sumter counties. Perman Eugene Williams was the president of Johnson Junior College, which served more than 400 students from Lake, Sumter, Hernando, Orange, Osceola, and Seminole counties during its existence. Permanent recognition was given to those who were linked with the history of Johnson Junior College in 1996, when the Leesburg Campus Administration Building was named the Williams-Johnson Administration Building in honor of Perman E. Williams and John Wesley Johnson.

Dr. Robert S. Palinchak served as LSCC's second president from 1980 to 1986. He was followed by Dr. Carl C. Andersen, whose tenure was from 1986 to 1992. Dr. Robert W. Westrick became the College's fourth president in May 1993. He retired June 30, 2002. On July 1, 2002, Dr. Charles R. Mojock became LSCC's fifth president. The College continues to grow, meeting the communities' higher education needs. The Sumter Campus opened in

Sumterville in 1995 and the South Lake Campus in Clermont opened in the fall of 1999.

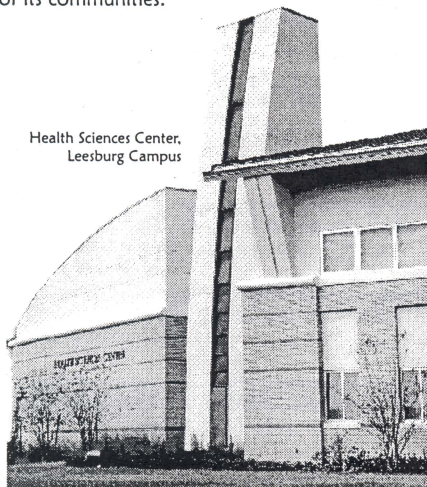
Serving more than 5,000 students annually, LSCC continues to have a major impact on the surrounding region. The College offers Associate in Arts (A.A.), Associate in Applied Science (A.A.S.), and Associate in Science (A.S.) degrees, certificate programs, and applied technology diploma. In addition to high school Dual Enrollment programs, non-credit and corporate training classes are also offered.

Through its university partnerships, LSCC has made it possible for students to enroll in 2+2 programs to earn Bachelor's degrees locally from the University of Central Florida and Saint Leo University.

Complementing its academic offerings, LSCC features a variety of athletic, entertainment, personal enrichment, and cultural programs and activities. In addition to ongoing intramural athletic activities, intercollegiate athletics began in the fall of 1998. LSCC participates in district and statewide competitions in the following sports: women's volleyball, men's baseball, and women's fastpitch softball.

In all ways, Lake Sumter Community College strives to fulfill its role and mission as a public, comprehensive College dedicated to the service of its communities.

LEESBURG CAMPUS

The Leesburg Campus began with a 70 acre site on U.S. Highway 441, across from the Leesburg Municipal Airport and bordering on beautiful Silver Lake. With the help and assistance of leading citizens, educators, and political figures, the College rapidly expanded and outgrew this site. In 1992, neighboring property was purchased for future expansion, enlarging the campus to 114 acres.

Among the major facilities are classrooms and laboratories, a library, the Learning Center, the Paul P. William Fine Arts Center, the Student Services Building, the Student Center, the Sports and Recreation Complex, and the Everett A. Kelly Convocation Center with a gymnasium and the Magnolia Room banquet/conference facility. In January 2002, the 31,800 sq. ft. Health Sciences Center opened for state-of-the-art health care programs in Nursing, Health Information Management and Dental Assisting. The facility includes classrooms, a nursing skills lab, library and offices, as well as a 1500 sq. ft. fitness center, a 100-seat auditorium, and a 40-seat community room.

SOUTH LAKE CAMPUS

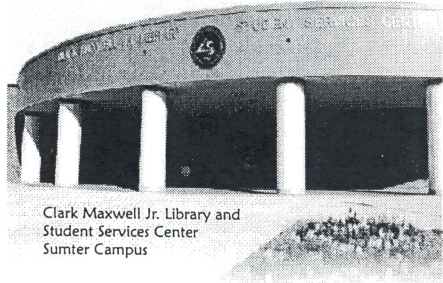
After several years of offering classes at South Lake High School and to better serve the needs of area residents, funding was obtained in 1998 to build Phase I of the South Lake Campus. Construction was completed and the first classes in the new building were held in the 1999 fall semester.

Phase II, a 60,000 sq. ft. joint-use facility with the University of Central Florida, was dedicated on March 1, 2002. Named the Higher Education Facility, but often called "The Castle on the Hill," the building houses classrooms, laboratories, faculty and administration offices, student services area, a 100-seat auditorium, and a third floor conference room with panoramic views of the Central Florida area.

In addition to LSCC's degree/certificate programs, there are opportunities to enroll in 2+2, four-year degree programs through the University of Central Florida. LSCC has also forged partnerships with neighboring South Lake Hospital and Wellness Center, and the National Training Center in order to enhance educational opportunities in South Lake County.

SUMTER CAMPUS

The LSCC Sumter Campus, located in Sumterville, opened its doors in the summer of 1995. The forty-acre campus includes classrooms, a library and administrative offices. It is also a joint-use facility shared with the Sumter County School District Adult Community Education Program. The Clark Maxwell, Jr. Library and Student Services Center was opened and dedicated in January 2000. It houses the Sumter County Library System and the only teleconferencing center in the county. St. Leo University offers a 2+2 program on the Sumter Campus leading to a Bachelor of Arts degree in Education.
